Have you heard about the Cyclone Gridiron Club?

The Cyclone Gridiron Club (CGC) is the official booster club of Iowa State University Football. The CGC raises money for the ISU football program to help with a variety of unbudgeted items and as well as some of the following items in support of the team:

- **Team meals** Did you know that a basic Gridiron membership helps feed five players team meals?
- **Technology for recruiting** The CGC recently purchased a new Jack Trice Game Day simulator for our coaches to recruit with and show potential players what type of environment they can expect, all while on the road visiting future players.
- Technology for practice and games Did you know that nearly one third of NFL teams and over 20 college teams (including Baylor, Florida State and Nebraska) are using Catapult GPS technology? The CGC purchased this new tool that players wear during practice and games in order to capture performance, intensity, acceleration, and deceleration statistics, along with detecting possible injuries earlier than normal.
- Spirit Walk We want all of our football players to look sharp as they enter the stadium. This is why the CGC purchases a new suit jacket for each new player on the team. One less expense the players have to worry about!
- State of the art weight room New weights and equipment were purchased by the Cyclone Gridiron Club to make our weight room training facility one of the best in the nation.

As a special offer, the Cyclone Gridiron Club would like to offer loyal ISU Alumni Band members a special member discount for the 2015-2016 football year. Each new member from the Alumni Band ranks will receive a 10% discount on any given CGC membership level. There are several opportunities:

Register by October 10 to reserve a performance spot during halftime. There will be a \$10 late fee applied after October 10, and registration will close October 25.

The Alumni Band official uniform is:

- Red shirt
- Black pants or Black jeans
- Black socks
- Black shoes
- Cyclone colored hats, gloves and scarves are OK as well

We encourage Cyclone colors with all accessories! If you do not have a jacket, you will need to purchase one with your registration for \$45. Recent graduates (2013 – 2015) and current students receive a discounted price of \$35. All jackets are men's sizes (S-4XL) and to guarantee your jacket size register EARLY, by OCTOBER 7. Football Tickets

If you have tickets to the Homecoming game vs. Texas, the Athletic Department policy does not allow tickets to be used for admittance to the stadium with the Alumni Band. Your registration fee includes admission to the game and seats with the band. If extra tickets to the game are needed for guests, those can be purchased with your registration at a discounted price.

Online Elections

This year elections will be held online before Homecoming reunion. An announcement will be made via Facebook and email with more specifics once Homecoming approaches. To submit your name for an open position, please indicate your interest through your registration form.

Instruments

The Iowa State University Band Department will supply the following items to those who will need them on Saturday, October 31:

- Mellophones
- Baritones
- Sousaphones
- Percussion
- Flags

If you need any of these items, please indicate as much in the appropriate spot on your registration form. Due to limited availability, all horns are on a first come first served basis. Those using borrowed instruments will still need to supply their own lyres, and will be responsible for returning their instrument to the proper place after the game. Those in need of other instruments not listed should try to locate them through other local sources, such as local schools, music stores, or other ISU band alumni.

Music flip folders will be provided at rehearsal Saturday. All other items (reeds, valve oil, etc.) are your responsibility.

Saturday Meal at Scheman

A Saturday meal is included with your full registration, or may be ordered separately if you do not intend on joining the band at the game. Saturday meals can also be ordered for guests through the registration form. All diners will need a meal ticket, which will be included in your registration packet. Packets can be picked up Friday night at Johnny's in Hilton, prior to Saturday rehearsal or outside the meeting room at Scheman prior to the meal.

Golden Alumni Shuttle

Some members may find the march from the Scheman Building to/from Jack Trice Stadium to be rather difficult. (It certainly is more difficult than the halftime drill!) If you are in need of transportation assistance, the Golden Alumni Shuttle will be available for use. This shuttle will also run from Scheman to the Bergstrom Indoor Practice Facility before rehearsal on Saturday. Please indicate on the registration form your desire to use the shuttle so that there is enough transportation for everyone. A map and shuttle schedule will be available on the Marching Band Homecoming page.

Marching Options

Did you know that there are several options for participating in the halftime show? There are three different options that can be chosen on your registration:

- March the halftime drill on the field "Marching On-Field"
- Enjoy the show from the sideline "Non-Marching Sideline"
- Stationary position on the field "Stationary On-Field"

The stationary on-field position is being offered as a less strenuous way to participate in Alumni Band. You'll still be on the field with the rest of the alumni band, but instead of marching the drill you will march on the field, stand and play, and then march off the field. How simple is that?! A limited number of these positions are available and they will be filled on a first come, first served basis so please register early if you are interested.

Hopefully everyone can find a participation level that will work for them in order to return to Alumni Band, or join us for the first time for the 35th reunion. Trust us, you can do it!
